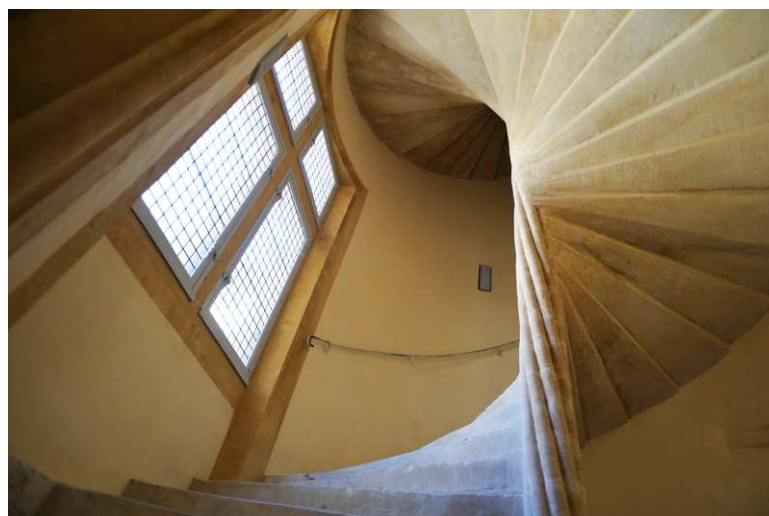

1 / Visit of the "Traboules" of the Old City of Lyon

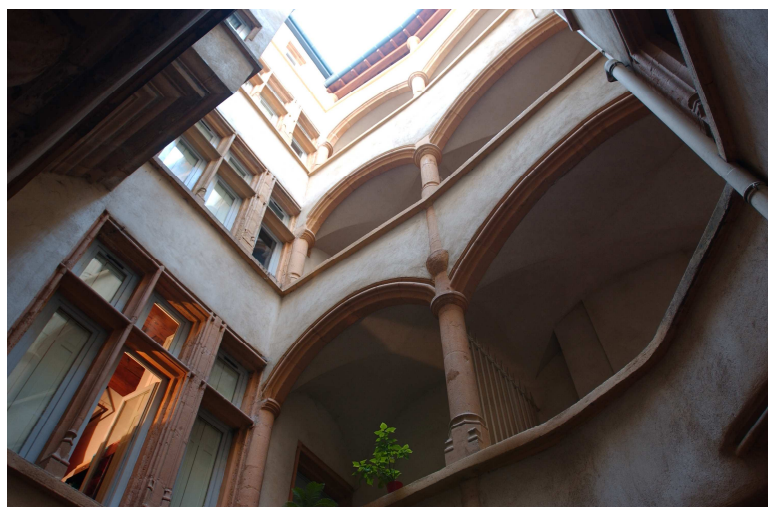


The "traboules" are famous covered passageways going from one street to the next via corridors through houses hide superbly renovated architectural treasures: inner courtyards, galleries "à l'italienne", spiral staircases, etc...

2/ Visit of the Middle Age town of Perouges

The medieval city of Perouges is an ancient fortified city located on a rocky place of the plateau of “Les Dombes”, overlooking the confluence of the Rhone



and the Ain rivers. You will visit the village, which belongs to the most beautiful villages of France, by walking in the paved streets.

You will visit the XII century village, discovering the old Castle and its fortifications. During your trip you will also visit the Old Perouges Museum where you will discover beautiful historical objects gathered to the old Perougian families.



3/ Visit of a Beaujolais Castle and its Cellars

Located near the village of Montmelas-Saint-Sorlin, in the Beaujolais region, the old castle of Montmelas is formerly (in the 10th century) a garrison place.



Becoming Marquis de Montmelas in 1566 Hehan Arod transformed the place in a castle. Since that time, they produce Beaujolais-Villages wines based mainly on Gamay grappes.



During your trip to Montmelas, you will visit, under the guidance of the owner the castle, the castle itself, the winery and the cellar. A tutorial on the wine production will precede the tasting of the home produced Beaujolais wines in the tasting room of the castle.
